The Wall That Heals is a program of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Fund (VVMF), the nonprofit organization that built the Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington, D.C. It is the only traveling exhibit affiliated with The Wall and features the largest replica of the Memorial that travels the country.

In August 2026, The Wall That Heals will come to Taylor, Michigan, offering our community a powerful opportunity to honor the more than three million Americans who served in the Vietnam War and to remember the 58,281 men and women whose names are inscribed on The Wall. The exhibit includes a three-quarter scale replica of the Memorial and a mobile Education Center with historical exhibits, veteran recognition programs, and guided tours. This event will be free and open to the public.
